We will end our Religious Education class in person with a Sunday Mass which starts at 11:30 am at the church. Students will walk with their catechist to the church and we ask parents to join their children in the pews with the posted sign of their grade.

THE SECURITY RULES TO BE APPLIED DURING RELIGIOUS CLASSES DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR 2020/2021:

1. Children and adults entering school must wear a mask.
2. Both teachers and students must wear a mask during the class period.
3. Every person entering school will have a temperature measured.
4. Every person entering the school will have their hands disinfected.
5. Desks in the classrooms will be set with social distance.
6. The use of hallways and bathrooms will be based on guidelines for the preservation of social distance.
7. Teachers will disinfect desks in the classrooms.
8. Parents/Guardians will only be allowed into the school in exceptional and necessary situations.
9. A student who has any symptoms of:
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat

- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

before school must stay at home.

10. If a student or family member has been diagnosed with COVID 19, the parent must immediately notify the school so that the entire class and teacher are quarantined for 14 days.
