## RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAM INFORMATION

#### Registration

For new and returning families, Registration will be on Sunday September 9<sup>th</sup> and September 16<sup>th</sup> from 8:30 am until 12:00 Noon, in the school office. The school office is open from 8AM. A \$60 registration deposit is requested at that time and will be applied to your tuition.

#### • Tuition Discounts

The office will be open for tuition payments on Sunday September 9<sup>th</sup> and September 16<sup>th</sup> and all Sundays that classes are in session. Please stop by and make your payments and complete your tuition agreement if you have not done so already. If you would like to participate in our Religious Education Program as a classroom teacher for the year, you will receive a tuition credit of \$150. If you volunteer to be a classroom assistant, you will receive a tuition credit of \$50. We welcome your participation in the program however the Religious Education Director reserves the right to make the final assignments for teachers and assistants.

#### • Baptismal Records

If your child has been baptized, all registrations must include a photocopy of the child's baptismal certificate that we will keep on file. We will be happy to make a copy for you if you bring in the original. If your child has not been baptized and you would like them to be prepared for that Sacrament, please let us know.

#### • Sacramental Preparation

There will be special events planned for parents and children preparing to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation (Confession), Eucharist (First Holy Communion) and Confirmation. If your family will be celebrating one of these sacraments this year, you will receive further details later regarding these events. If you or any other member of your family needs sacramental preparation, please let us know and we will tell you how you can go about it.

#### • Attendance

We will meet for 29 sessions. Please see the attached calendar for exact dates. Attendance also includes participation at the 10:00 am Mass in the Chapel by the whole family unless other arrangements are made with the DRE.

#### • Mass Participation

Parents are asked to come to Chapel by 9:50 AM and sit with their child's class for the Mass. Your child will join you there. Please help your child follow the Mass using the Sunday Mass Book, listening to the readings and the Homily and singing. Children should not be talking or playing during Mass and please, no gum chewing.

#### • Program and Prayers

Students will be expected to learn:

**Kindergarten** – Know the Sign of the Cross; genuflecting correctly, sit quietly in Church without talking or playing.

**1<sup>st</sup> Gr** – Know the Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be; genuflecting correctly with the Sign of the Cross

**2<sup>nd</sup> Gr** – Know all of the above, prepare to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist

**3<sup>rd</sup> Gr** – Know all of the above, learn about the Ten Commandments, being one, holy, Catholic, and apostolic (the Creed)

**4<sup>th</sup> Gr** – Know all of the above, learn about the Holy Trinity, our Blessed Mother, and the Church calendar

**5<sup>th</sup> Gr** – Know all of the above, learn about the seven sacraments: God's gifts of Life

**6<sup>th</sup> Gr** – Know all of the above, learn about the Old Testament, and answering God's call

**7<sup>th</sup> Gr** – Know all of the above, learn about the New Testament and the Pascal Mystery

**8<sup>th</sup> Gr** – Know all of the above and prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation

#### • Important Notes

Every year we receive calls about children who have missed receiving a sacrament. This includes grade school aged children who have not yet been baptized, children in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade or older who have not yet received the Sacraments of Reconciliation or Holy Eucharist, or teenagers who have not yet been Confirmed. If this is the situation in your family and you would like your child(ren) to be prepared to receive these sacraments, please call **Beata Bosak** as soon as possible.
